Housed in a converted Richmond warehouse, the venue blends industrial charm with a welcoming atmosphere, creating a vibrant community hub for customers and visitors alike.

### Project Design Brief

A corrosion-resistant drainage system was essential for the new production site. Designers specified built-in falls within the channels to ensure efficient drainage to outlet points, preventing any standing water. Safety was also a key consideration, with the system designed to allow brewery staff to move around equipment without the risk of slipping.
